Room Allocation

When you arrive at Rutherford Park, on the wall of the main building you will find a list indicating the room allocated to each person, the person with whom you will be sharing (if relevant), and a map of the buildings (with room numbers) so you can find your room.

What to bring

Linen, blankets, pillows and towels are all supplied.

You will need to prepare for a variety of possible climates, so you need warm clothing, clothes for possible warmer weather, and something waterproof (jacket etc).

There will be copies of APBA and Together in Song available. You will need to bring a Bible and notebook.

What happens on the first day?

Registration is from 2pm. Tea and coffee will be available in the dining area (and usually a warming fire if the weather is cold).

The Clergy Conference session of the Retreat begins at 2.30, with afternoon tea during this session, followed by evening prayer. See the attached timetable for a full programme of the Retreat.
