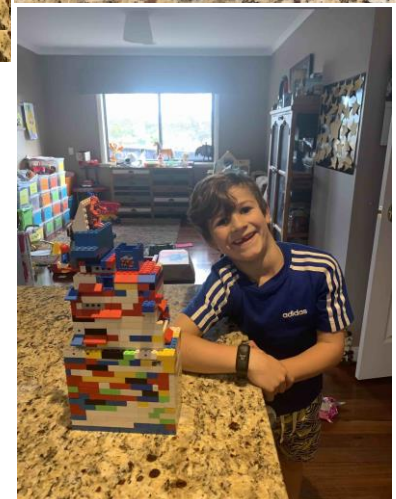
We will have some form of Easter theme next week then the following weeks will be something like some of these examples below.
