Passage - John 21:1-19 - Jesus forgives Peter

Background:

Each day we make choices. Some of those choices are good and some are not so good!

This week we are looking at the disciple Peter and how he made some bad choices and we will look at how Jesus responded to those choices. Read **Matthew 26:31-35** and **Matthew 26:69-75** to read the background to today's passage and then read **John 21:1-19** to see what happened.

Questions for you to think about together.....

1. Before Jesus was crucified, he warned Peter of an upcoming sin (Matthew 26:31-35). What sin did Jesus tell Peter he would commit?
2. What was Peter's reaction when it happened (Matthew 26:69-75)?
3. Jesus had a special promise for Peter even though he knew Peter would deny him. Read Matthew 16:18. What promises did Jesus make to Peter?
4. What does this teach us about Jesus?
5. In John 21:15-17, Jesus asked Peter a number of questions. Peter knew that he was forgiven and he accepted the love and forgiveness of Jesus. Do you forgive others when they hurt you?

Key Verse – John 21:17

“Lord, ...you know that I love you.”

Wrap Up

Even though Peter had made mistakes, he was forgiven and God used Peter to grow the early church. No matter what we do, God is always ready to forgive us and welcome us back as His precious children so that we can continue serving him.
