Bishop in Council recently updated the child safe policies in light of new <u>Child Safe Standards</u> from the Commission for Children and Young People.

Statement of Commitment to Child Safety

At Synod a new **Statement of Commitment to Child Safety** was unanimously endorsed:

The Anglican Diocese of Bendigo is committed to keeping children and young people safe.

As a church we:

- recognise the pain and suffering of survivors of childhood abuse;
- commit to promoting a child safe culture throughout all levels of our church;
- are especially aware of children's diverse backgrounds, circumstances and needs and commit to providing equal protection to all children and young people and actively work to address racism and discrimination
- welcome ongoing legislative change that improves child safety in organisations;
- endorse and are determined to comply with the Victorian Child Safe Standards in order to be a child safe church;
- support the National Principles for Child Safe
 Organisations recommended by the Royal
 Commission into Institutional Responses to Child
 Sexual Abuse,
- encourage ongoing child safe education and policy development in our diocese
- commit to creating environments that allow children and young people to reach their potential and thrive in all areas of their wellbeing, including spiritual wellbeing.
- ensure appropriate support and reporting mechanisms are in place for children and young people when they have concerns or complaints
- value the voice of all children and young people and actively seek their opinions and views

We have adapted the Trust Withdrawal & Property Proposal forms to only require one signature. Easy as pie! Uploading Parish Council meeting minutes is sufficient evidence of wider consultation.

A massive thank you to those parishes you have starting submitting the online forms. As we establish this new system there will be tweaks & clarifications along the way. Here are a few:

Gutter Vac

Gulliver, our diocesan Gutter Vac, will be visiting one deanery at a time and is currently on tour in Campaspe. Deanery leaders will notified when it is their turn to host Gulliver. Thanks for your patience as we share the 'leaf love' around!

Volunteer Agreements

We are preparing example Volunteer Agreements and will get them to you as soon as possible.

Safe Church

If your parish doesn't run any children's ministry activities, then your only task here is to check that the registry list of names reflects this. If we have a name listed that is no longer accurate, we need to know. You can then apply for this rebate.

Fire Readiness

Please attach the required evidence to your application. Photos are required to demonstrate to our Insurers that we are following their codes. Tech-wise, the easiest option is to take the photo with the same device that you will fill in the online form. Ie. a tablet or laptop.
